UKC Agility Titles

BEGINNER AGILITY (BA) (formerly UAGI)

Earn 3 qualifying scores of 170 or higher.

INTERMEDIATE AGILITY II (IA) (UAGII)

Have a BA title and earn 3 qualifying scores of 170 or higher.

UNITED AGILITY CHAMPION (UACH)

Have earned BA and AI titles.

Earned by accumulating 100 points in BA and IA B classes. At least 40 points must be earned in BA and 40 must be earned in IA. Points are earned with qualifying scores of 195 or higher.

UNITED AGILITY CHAMPION EXCELLENT (UACHX)

Have a UACH title and receive 5 qualifying scores of 195 or higher in AGIII.

UNITED GRAND AGILITY CHAMPION (UGRACH)

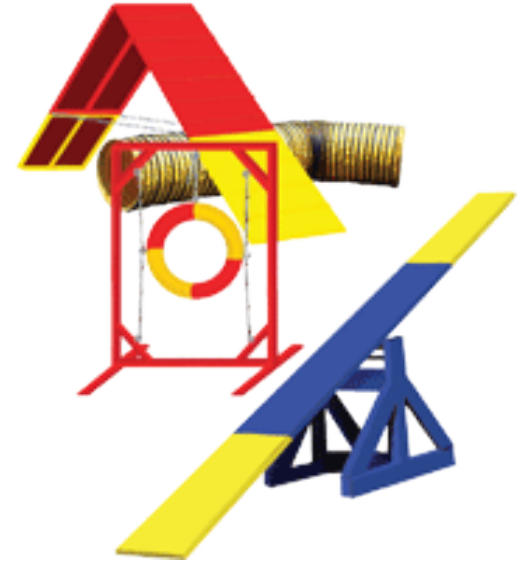
Have a UACHX title, and earn legs at 5 different UKC licensed trials. A leg is earned by receiving qualifying scores of 195 or higher in BA, IA and EA (AGI, AGII, and AGIII) classes, in the same trial (Trial 1 or Trial 2), for a combined score of 590 or higher.

UKC Agility Classes

BEGINNER AGILITY (BA) (AGI-A & AGI-B)

(Section A is open to dogs that have not earned a BA (AGI) title. After earning the title the dog competes in section B with other titled dogs.)

Relatively simple running path for beginner dogs. Obstacles placed at least 12' apart.

13-16 obstacles:

Non-hurdle obstacles:

- A-frame
- Dog Walk
- Teeter-Totter
- Open Tunnel
- Hoop Tunnel
- Barrel

Hurdle obstacles: Minimum of 6 are required.

- Bar Hurdle
- Bush Hurdle
- High Hurdle
- Log Hurdle
- Long Hurdle
- Picket Fence Hurdle
- Rail Fence Hurdle
- Spread Hurdle
- Tire Jump

Pause Table is required.

Ready, set, go!

First, register your dog with UKC. (Forms are available online at www.ukcdogs.com)

Performance Listing allows any mixed breed dogs, purebred with unknown pedigree, or spayed/neutered dogs to compete in performance events.

Single Registration is a method for purebred dogs from other recognized registries to become UKC registered.

~Dogs must be 15 months of age to compete in Agility.

~Handlers must have plenty of patience, practice, and positivity with your dogs! Have fun!

INTERMEDIATE AGILITY (IA) (AGII-A & B)

(Section A is open to dogs that have not earned an IA title. After earning the title the dog competes in section B with other titled dogs.)

Moderate to slightly complex path for more advanced dogs. Obstacles may be as close as 8' apart to present more obstacle discrimination choices.

Delimiting Line: At least 2 obstacles must have a delimiting line drawn two (2) feet away, requiring the handler to send the dog from behind the line.

16 to 20 obstacles:

Non-hurdle obstacles: a minimum of 7 are required. Any may be used twice, except Weaves.

Required obstacles:

- Hoop Tunnel
- Weave Poles (6, 9, or 12)

Optional Obstacles: May be used twice.

- Swing Plank
- Sway Bridge
- Open Tunnel
- Barrel
- Teeter-Totter

Hurdle Obstacles: Minimum of 8 are required, chosen from the hurdles listed under BA classes.

Pause obstacle: (choose one):

- 1) Pause Box
- 2) Pause Table

Trap Obstacles: May be used, but are not required.

Entering a Trial:

1. Find an event through UKC's website, your training center, or local club.
2. Decide if you want to pre-enter the event (usually at discounted cost), or enter day-of-show if your plans or the weather are uncertain.
3. Download and print the Official UKC Entry Form (www.ukcdogs.com). Mail the completed form with payment for entry fees to the club's event secretary.

EXCELLENT AGILITY (EA) (AGIII)

(Open to eligible dogs that have earned the UACH title or higher.)

Complex path with no minimum distance between obstacles, to test advanced obstacle discrimination.

Delimiting Line: At least 2 obstacles must have a delimiting line drawn six (6) feet away, requiring the handler to send the dog from behind the line.

16 to 22 obstacles:

Non-hurdle obstacles: Minimum of 7 are required. Any obstacle may be used twice except for Weave Poles (9 & 12).

- Dog Walk
- Teeter-Totter
- A-frame
- Hoop Tunnel
- Open Tunnel
- Barrel
- Swing Plank
- Sway Bridge
- Weave Poles (9 or 12)*

*Weave Poles (6,9 or 12) may be used as follows:

- * 6 weaves counts as one obstacle.
- * 9 weaves counts as one obstacle.
- * 12 weaves counts as one obstacle.
- * 12 weaves may be split into 2 sets of 6, and counts as two obstacles.

Hurdle Obstacles: Minimum of 9 are required, chosen from the hurdles listed under BA.

Pause obstacle: one is required. Select from:

- Pause Box
- Pause Table

Trap Obstacles: May be used but are not required.

Scoring:

A perfect score is 200.

A qualifying score is 170 in BA and IA.

A qualifying score in EA (AGIII) is 195.

A score lower than 170 is NQ (non-qualifying).
